

KCJS Summer Scholarship Application Instructions

The Kyoto Consortium for Japanese Studies (KCJS) offers a limited number of scholarships for participation in the KCJS summer program. The number and amount of awards vary depending on the pool of applicants but the awards can range from \$500-\$2,000.

Eligibility

- Students must be admitted to the KCJS summer program and demonstrate financial need.
 Students who do not receive financial aid but can demonstrate financial need are welcome to apply by submitting a FAFSA Student Aid Report.
- Applications must be submitted with the required materials. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Application Deadline

Due at the same as the KCJS program application materials
